Findings and Achievements

WP3 represents a major step toward integrating disaster preparedness into continuing education systems.

Key achievements include:

- Development of a comprehensive Disaster Awareness & Life-Saving Skills Curriculum
- Design of 30 training modules structured across five thematic units
- Creation of an inclusive pedagogical framework tailored to diverse learner groups
- Strengthening educators' capacity through problem-based and action-oriented teaching methods
- Integration of ESCO transversal skills and resilience competences
- Inclusion of real-life scenarios, critical thinking exercises, and practical preparedness guidance
